

QEP Assessment Plan

SENSE Survey – Fall 2015

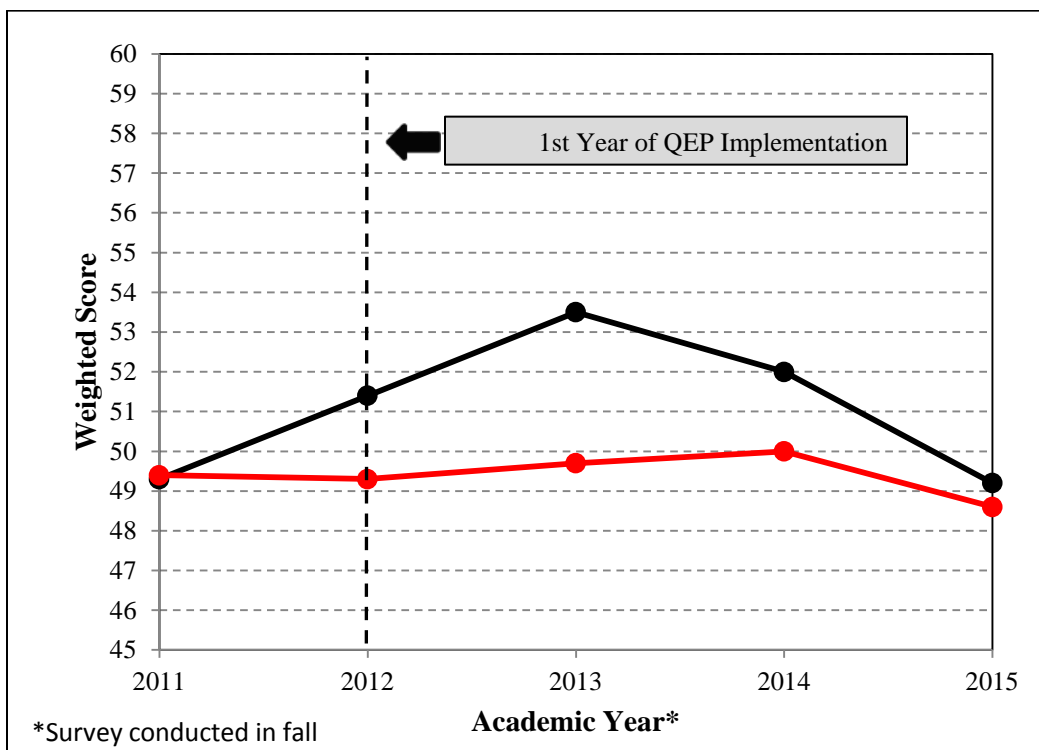


Figure 1/Table 1. SENSE Engaged Learning Benchmark Results through time comparing FSW results (black) with extra-large college comparison results (red) as provided by the Center for Community College Student Engagement. SENSE Surveys are conducted annually in the fall semester.

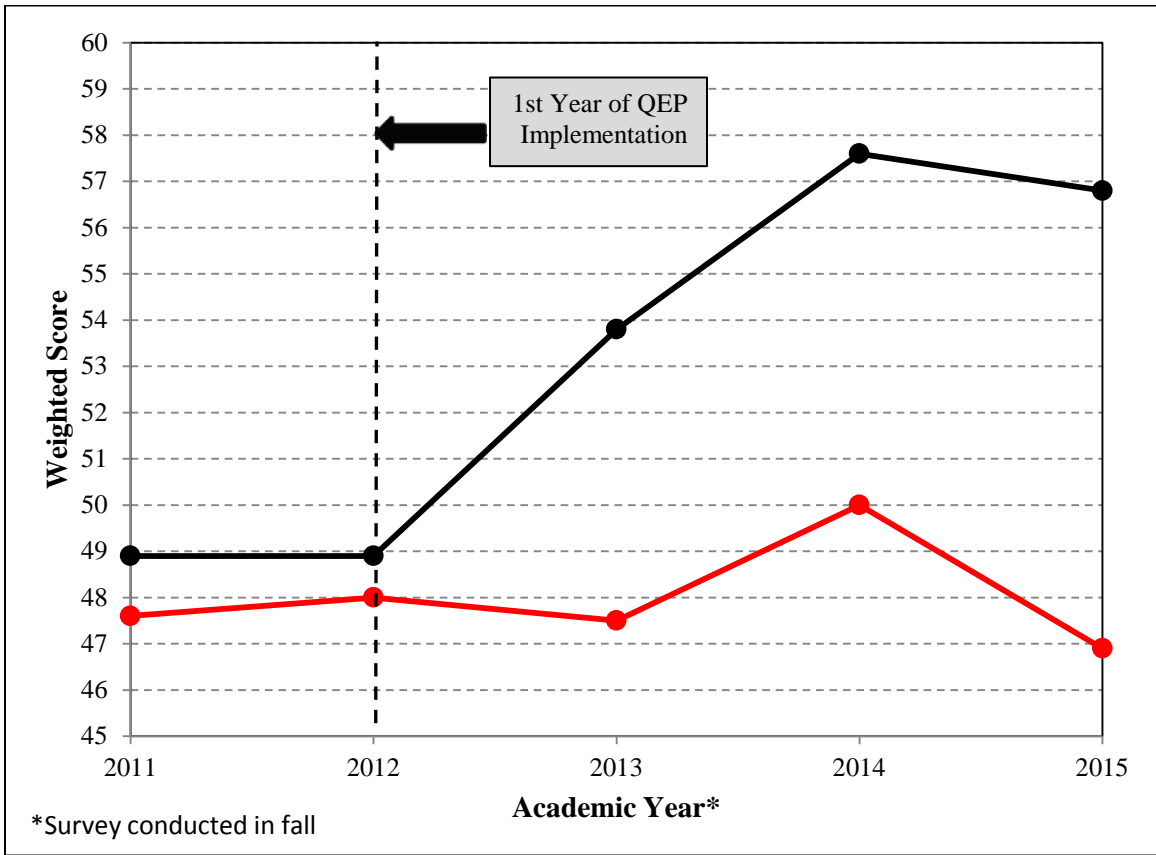


Figure 2. SENSE Clear Academic Plan & Pathway Benchmark Results through time comparing FSW results (black) with extra-large college comparison results (red) as provided by the Center for Community College Student Engagement. SENSE Surveys are conducted annually in the fall semester.

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Florida SouthWestern’s assessment measures for the Quality Enhancement Plan (QEP) include measurements of student satisfaction/engagement and student academic plans. Eighty-nine course sections were randomly selected from ENC 0022 *Writing for College Success*, ENC 1101 *Composition I*, MAT0057 *Mathematics College Success*, MAT 1033 *Intermediate Algebra*, MAC 1100 *Mathematical Literacy*, MAC 1105 *College Algebra*, MAC 1114 *Trigonometry*, MAC 1140 *Pre-Calculus Algebra*, MGF 1107 *Math for Liberal Arts II*, and REA 0019 *Reading for College Success* in fall 2015. From those sections 1171 surveys were administered. The results of the SENSE Engaged Learning Benchmark are shown in Figure 1/Table 1. Results of the Clear Academic Plan and Pathway Benchmark are shown in Figure 2/Table 2.
