LEARNING OUTCOME (S):

1. Student is knowledgeable about appropriate resources that will apply to specific student needs.
2. Student is knowledgeable about proper classes to take their first semester based on their college placement scores.
3. Student is knowledgeable about how to access and utilize the different components of their portal account.
4. Student accepts responsibility for being an active learner in all classes and when it is necessary to seek out needed assistance.
5. Student is knowledgeable about the Official Academic Calendar and accepts responsibility for necessary actions to be taken by deadlines.

ASSESSMENT PLAN: Survey conducted at the conclusion of Orientation.

DATA ANALYSIS:

1,449 students were given the survey during the fall 2010 orientation; 1,426 (98.4%) participated while 23 (1.6%) declined. Complete results are attached. The survey addressed all five student learning outcome goals with the exception of goal #4 which was written in a way as which to be unattainable. The orientation garnered an average rating of 4.54 utilizing a non-forced choice Likert scale with 5 indicating "very satisfied."

USE OF ASSESSMENT FINDINGS TO IMPROVE STUDENT LEARNING:**Recommended Changes Based on Assessment Findings**

Assessment findings indicated a need for more specific and measurable learning outcomes.

Minor changes were made in regard toward wording and forcedness of choice.

OTHER RECOMMENDATIONS: The orientation program is currently being evaluated via a QEP sub-committee.
