Peer Architects Expectations

- Be polite and friendly, project an image of positivity that encourages students to interact with you.
- Speak positively about Florida SouthWestern State College, including faculty, staff, administrators, and students.
- Be prompt and show up on-time for all scheduled shifts.
- Dress appropriately: wear specific staff polo with appropriate bottoms when assigned.
- Be motivational and attentive to student's needs.
- Approach FSW students and visitors with a friendly demeanor.
- Be knowledgeable about basic FSW facts, the enrollment process, campus resources, and college procedures including testing policies, class registration, college catalog, and the academic calendar.
- Peer Architects build unique mentor / mentee relationships with Cornerstone Experience students, therefore Peer Architects are not permitted to pursue a relationship with any SLS 1515 student.
- Peer Architects must consult their supervisor prior to engaging in a relationship with another staff member at the college.
