## Class “C” Drinking Water Operators Training - Certificate Program

This course prepares the student for the Class “C” Drinking Water License State Exam, as well as, provides the student with the practical skills necessary to safely operate and maintain various drinking water treatment systems and appurtenances. Topics to be covered include operational problem solving, plant safety and maintenance. Additional topics covered include operational procedures and mathematical calculations relating to water treatment process control. Successful completion of this course: requires a grade of “C” or better as evidenced by the final exam; culminates in the receipt of a certificate of completion; and satisfies the Florida Department of Environmental Protection’s course prerequisite for taking the State Drinking Water Class “C” Exam. The course will be a combination of lecture, demonstrations, and plant visitation.
