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# Supplier Qualifications

Section 7.4 of the ISO 9001 Standard states that companies shall "evaluate and select suppliers based on their ability to supply product in accordance with the organization's requirements."

The most common approach is to ask for some combination of the following: 1) ISO certification, 2) a copy of the suppliers Quality System Manual, 3) completion of a supplier questionnaire, and 4) performing a supplier audit. Unfortunately, all four selection criteria are flawed.
