

Florida SouthWestern Collegiate High School - Lee Campus is a public charter high school with an open enrollment policy. All Florida SouthWestern Collegiate High School students follow an honors level and STEM based curriculum, providing students with the opportunity to graduate with an associate degree and high school diploma simultaneously.

Our curriculum and student management philosophies follow the nationally recognized pre-collegiate / collegiate model where students take honors level classes during their freshmen and sophomore years in a traditional high school facility. For eligible students, the junior and senior years consist of dual enrollment classes taken on the campus of Florida SouthWestern State College where students are offered all the challenges and rewards of being independent learners. This course of study affords participants the opportunity to earn a high school diploma and an associate of arts degree in just four years of study. With this tremendous opportunity comes an expectation to be highly motivated and focused on academic pursuits beginning the very first day of the very first year of school. Potential students should be prepared to have academics as their primary school priority and are expected to exhibit a high degree of personal integrity and social maturity during their experience at FSWCHS - Lee.

In order to participate, all potential students are offered the process outlined below:

- 1. Please plan on attending an open house event on:
 - o November 27th, December 11th, or January 15th
 - All sessions at FSWCHS Lee in the cafeteria 6:30 p.m. 8:00 p.m.
 - Students are NOT required to attend an open house but are required to submit a lottery registration.
- 2. Submit a lottery registration to Florida SouthWestern Collegiate High School during our lottery registration window that opens on November 27th and closes on March 1st
 - Lottery registrations will be accepted in person during business hours
 (7:30 am 2:30 pm) at FSWCHS Lee and at all open house sessions.
 - Details about on-line lottery registration will be available on November 27th via this website and during the open house event.
 - Application will not be "live" until November 27, 2012.

- Student admissions are granted through our enrollment lottery; no preference is given for early submission, GPA, test scores, or other potential criteria.
 - State law provides for sibling and employee preference through this process but all students must submit a lottery registration.
- 3. The lottery will be open to the public, in the FSWCHS Lee cafeteria and held on Tuesday, March 12, 2012 at 6:30 p.m.
 - This will rank order the registrations and this rank ordering will establish both the initial 100 students and create an ordered waiting list. Please remember that state statute requires that sibling and employee preference considerations.
 - Registrants will receive a phone call and written notification of their status after the lottery within 48 hours.
- 4. If your student is offered a seat during the initial lottery, you will have until an established date to accept the seat by submitting either a full enrollment packet or a written notice declining your seat. The deadline date will be announced at the lottery. Students offered seats after that date will have 48 hours to respond.
 - Non-responses will be considered to be declining the seat.
 - While the US mail is an option for submitting documents, applicants are highly encouraged to hand deliver, fax, or e-mail the enrollment packet so that there is less chance of missing the deadline.
- 5. Specific information for selected students related to starting the 2013 2014 school year will be available at a new student orientation held in mid April.
