SUMMARY: School of Health Professions Limited Admission Programs

Students may apply to a Limited Admission degree program without completing all *Program Specific Courses*. However, the *Minimum Requirements to Apply* must be satisfied before the application deadline. Admission is based on a point system. Points are earned by calculating GPA and number of *Program Specific Courses* completed. Some programs may also require and calculate admission points earned on an entrance test, personal interview, and essay. Applicants who complete all *Program Specific Courses*, before applying, will earn more admission points. However, students with excellent GPAs, strong test scores, and successful interview skills can be admitted <u>before</u> completing all *Program Specific Courses*. Refer to each <u>Academic Programs</u> website for specific admission requirements. Also, please note that several courses require prerequisites, placement testing, testing exemption, and/or completion of all developmental courses in math, reading, and writing. **Transfer Students:** Transfer courses must be equivalent to FSW Program Specific Courses. Courses evaluated on your FSW Unofficial Transcript as GEE XXXX are not considered equivalent please see your College Advisor for more details.
