SOCIAL AND BEHAVIORAL SCIENCES & HUMAN SERVICES PATHWAY ASSOCIATE IN SCIENCE DEGREE (A.S.): SOCIAL & HUMAN SERVICES

Catalog Year 2024-25

The Social and Human Services degree can be completed online with the exception of the one semester residency, with many courses also offered on campus. Students who attend full-time can complete the program within 5 semesters, or 2 years. Or, students may take longer to complete the degree and attend on a part-time basis. All courses must be completed with a C or higher. Courses include General Education (15 credits), Social and Human Services Core (36 credits), and Specialty Track/Electives (9 credits) for a total of 60 credits. All students who complete the degree will also earn the Human Services Generalist Certificate. Students may choose from one of the following Specialty Tracks: Youth Development or Addiction Services. Alternatively, students may take 9 credits of electives that can go towards transferring to a bachelor's degree.*

* This option requires 3 additional credits and careful planning with your Advisor.
