

# Fine Arts Scholarships

for Music, Theatre, and Visual Arts



Scholarships up to \$2000 per semester are available to FSW students seeking an Associate in Arts degree with an emphasis in Fine Arts (honorariums or performance grants may be available for specific classes and ensembles to students not pursuing an emphasis in Fine Arts).

All scholarship applicants will be required to complete the scholarship application indicating interest in FSW fine arts scholarships (found at [www.fsw.edu/financialaid/scholarships](http://www.fsw.edu/financialaid/scholarships)) and present an audition or portfolio.
