

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
FLORIDA SOUTHWESTERN STATE COLLEGE
AND
HODGES UNIVERSITY

WHEREAS, Florida SouthWestern State College (FSW), and Hodges University (HU), desire to work together in order to provide for the matriculation of FSW Associate Degree Graduates into HU's Baccalaureate degree programs as more specifically set forth herein;

WHEREAS, FSW and HU agree to be bound by the terms of this Agreement, but also agree to work in good faith with each other as any particular situation or situations may arise for the benefit of their students;

WHEREAS, it is FSW and HU's intention that this Agreement facilitate a seamless transition from the Associate program at FSW to the Baccalaureate program at HU; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of mutual promises, covenants and conditions contained herein, FSW and HU agree as follows:

Article 1. Agreement on General Principles.

1.1 FSW and HU agree that they shall each maintain regional accreditation and, if at any point, either FSW or HU should lose its regional accreditation, this Agreement shall be terminated as hereinafter provided.

1.2 Policies and procedures governing student academic concerns shall be those of HU. Academic concerns are defined as issues relating to admission, course registration, transfer of credit, transcripts, grades, testing, and others relating to the students' pursuit of a degree. FSW and HU agree to cooperate reasonably where each may have an interest in the issue in question. HU agrees to publish program audit sheets that FSW can make available to its students so that they can know in advance which courses will transfer and what total number of articulated credits HU will award for each applicable FSW degree.

1.3 The transfer of credits shall be governed by the transfer policies of HU; provided, however, that FSW and HU shall cooperate with each other to the extent their respective policies allow in order to facilitate the transfer of credits and the seamless transition of Associate to Baccalaureate degrees contemplated in this Agreement.

1.4 FSW students shall be eligible for admission and transfer into the Baccalaureate programs according to the plan described in Appendix A: Approved Programs,

attached hereto, providing such students meet the general admissions requirements specified in HU undergraduate catalog.

- 1.5 A completed Associate Degree, as specified in Appendix A, is the requirement for transition from FSW to HU's Baccalaureate program.

Article 3. Agreement on Program Services.

- 3.1 FSW and HU staff will cooperate and coordinate with one another regarding program information, communication, public relations activities and the development of other publications.
- 3.2 FSW will support HU admissions and advising services for students seeking to transition into HU's Baccalaureate programs.
- 3.3 Use of any and all FSW facilities and services shall be subject to FSW's written policies and procedures.
- 3.4 HU agrees that it shall instruct all of its employees and representatives that they shall be expected to conduct business in a professional manner, and to abide by the same rules of conduct applicable to personnel at FSW, at any and all times when present on FSW campuses or otherwise participating in any activity related to this Agreement. FSW reserves the right to require HU to remove any HU employee or representative from its campuses upon FSW's reasonable request.

Article 4. Termination of Agreement.

- 4.1 FSW and HU are committed to the concept of a long-standing agreement. This Agreement may be modified, but only in writing, as the parties deem fit over the course of time in order to deal with new and changing situations, different course offerings, etc. Amendments may be formal written modifications or may be in the form of letters signed by duly authorized representatives of FSW and HU.
- 4.2 The foregoing notwithstanding, either FSW or HU may terminate all of the portions of this Agreement by providing no less than six months' advance written notice to do so, unless the parties agree otherwise. Teach out provisions for students enrolled under this Agreement must be included in the written notice.

APPENDIX A: APPROVED PROGRAMS

The parties, through this document, agree to cooperate in articulating programs in accordance with the terms set forth herein.

1. Hodges University will accept students completing an Associate of Science in Computer Programming and Analysis at FSW into HU's Bachelor of Science in Software Development.
2. Hodges University will accept students completing an Associate of Science in Networking Services Technology at FSW into HU's Bachelor of Science in Networking.
3. Hodges University will accept students completing an Associate of Science in Architectural Design and Construction Technology at FSW into HU's Bachelor in Science in Digital Design and Graphics.
4. Hodges University will accept students completing an Associate of Science in Human Services at FSW into HU's Bachelor of Science in Applied Psychology.
5. Hodges University will accept credits in transfer for the above listed programs as indicated on the attached audit sheets. Students who have earned additional credits at FSW or other accredited institutions may also present these credits for transfer consideration. Students must meet the specific degree requirements, which may mean extending the number of credit hours to earn the degree. At least 48 credits must be completed at the 3000 or 4000 level in order to earn a Bachelor's Degree from Hodges University.
6. Students covered under this Agreement will receive a \$100 per credit hour tuition scholarship from Hodges University.

The terms outlined in Article 4 of the main body of this document apply to modification and termination.
