



 - Understanding their disability
 - Brainstorming/creating plans of action
- Connecting to other campus and local resources
 - Academic Success Center
 - Vocational Rehabilitation & Division of Blind Services
- Organizational tips and suggestions for their College planner
- Improve self-advocacy
 - Assist with email etiquette
 - Role play uncomfortable conversations with professors
- Computer lab with assistive technology
 - Also located in the libraries college-wide
- Loan Program
 - Students borrow textbooks, calculators, FM boxes, digital recorders, etc.
- Inclusive testing environment
