WHAT IS EAP?

English for Academic Purposes (EAP) is a series of courses to help students develop the Academic English skills needed for success in college courses. Students will receive direct instruction, participate in pair and group assignments, and utilize language learning technology to develop English language arts.

EAP LEVELS & COURSES

- After taking the EAP placement test, students are placed into one of three levels: 3, 4, or 5.
- There are four classes in each level:
 - Speech and Listening (3 Credits)
 - Grammar (3 Credits)
 - Reading (3 Credits)
 - Writing (3 Credits)

WHAT STEPS ARE REQUIRED TO GET STARTED IN EAP?

1. APPLY TO FSW

- Complete an admissions application online at www.fsw.edu/admissions
- Identify your student type and click on the title that best describes you
- Click "Apply Online" to complete the application
- Select "AA GENR" as your degree on the application
- Complete the application and pay the \$30 application fee

2. SUBMIT YOUR TRANSCRIPTS

- Submit all high school/GED and college transcripts to FSW.
- Foreign transcripts must be evaluated and translated by a NACES approved agency.

3. TAKE YOUR EAP PLACEMENT TEST

- Once you have received your FSW student identification number, make an appointment for EAP testing at <u>www.fsw.edu/testing</u>

- After completing the test, you will be placed into one of three levels (3-5).

4. COMPLETE YOUR ONLINE NEW STUDENT ORIENTATION

 To complete Orientation, visit the FSW homepage, click the Canvas icon, and login with your MyFSW username and password. On the Dashboard, click on the FSW Online Orientation course. For more information, please visit www.fsw.edu/orientation

5. MEET WITH YOUR STUDENT SUCCESS ADVISOR AND REGISTER FOR CLASSES

 Once you have completed testing and orientation, schedule an appointment with your Student Success Advisor. You will receive an email with instructions to schedule a workshop or an appointment with your Advisor
