HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA

Official final high school transcript that shows the date when the diploma was awarded.

 STATE CERTIFICATE (GED test, HiSET, TASC, or other Stateauthorized examination)

An official State certificate or transcript after the student passed a State-authorized examination that the State recognizes as the equivalent of a high school diploma

TWO-YEAR PROGRAM COMPLETION

An official academic transcript that indicates the student successfully completed at least a two-year program that is acceptable for full credit toward a bachelor's degree.

FOREIGN INSTITUTION

Official Transcript Evaluation must be completed of the "secondary school leaving certificate" (transcript must be transcribed to English) by an approved National Association™ of Credential Evaluation Services.

HOME SCHOOLED STUDENTS

Check off applicable circle and submit documentation:

<u>IF</u> the student who was homeschooled in a State where State law requires the student to obtain a secondary school completion credential for homeschooling (other than a high school diploma or its recognized equivalent), an official copy of that credential.

IF the student who was homeschooled in a State where State law does not require the student to obtain a secondary school completion credential for homeschooling (other than a high school diploma or its recognized equivalent), an official transcript, signed by the student's parent or guardian, that lists the secondary school courses the student completed and includes a statement that the student successfully completed a secondary school education in a homeschool setting.
