## Ambassador Scholarship \$8.000

· Merit-based, requires a minimum unweighted 3.0 high school GPA

## Academic Promise Scholarship \$6,000

Need-based

## **Academic Perseverance \$2.500**

- Earned a minimum of 45 college credit hours as a Dual Enrolled or Early Admit student
- Merit-based, requires a minimum unweighted 3.0 college GPA

## Academic Endurance \$4,000

- Earned a minimum of 30 college credit hours
- Need-based

## **Academic Advancement \$6,000**

- Enrolled in Bachelor Degree program
- Need-based
