- Investment records, including 529 plans of other prepaid college plans (if applicable)
- Records of untaxed income (if applicable)
- An FSA ID to sign electronically (A new FSA ID must be created for both the student and one parent - use separate e-mail addresses for each)
- Permanent Residency card (if not a U.S. Citizen)
- Driver's license number if available
