## Programming

This fall, the Office of First Year Experience will host **383** academic workshops helping students build competencies in areas such as learning skills and techniques, academic technology, transition knowledge and skills, and key cognitive strategies. During September and October **3,514** students benefitted from the workshops and **95.35%** of surveyed student participants "strongly agree" or "agree" that the session increased their knowledge of the topic.
