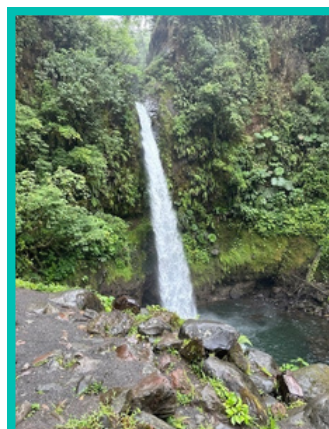
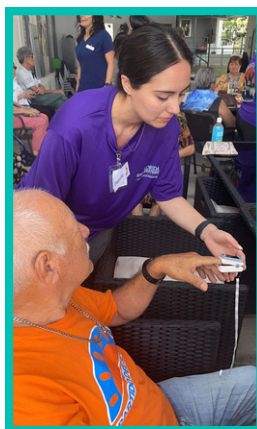
**Estimated Cost: \$2,800**
