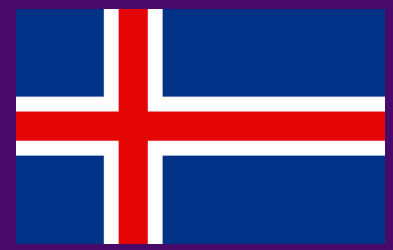


# Study Abroad in Iceland
