Travel to Norway while studying the legendary Viking sagas in the landscapes that inspired them. This faculty-led program introduces students to Norse literature, myth, and culture through close reading of Icelandic and Norwegian sagas paired with site-based learning in Oslo and the fjord regions. Students will explore Viking ships, longhouses, medieval cities, and dramatic coastal and mountain environments, connecting literary themes of honor, exile, and adventure to real places and artifacts. The course combines classroom discussion, museum visits, and guided excursions to offer an immersive introduction to Viking Age storytelling and Norse cultural history.
