



Growth Before Grades: Building College Readiness Conference

Rationale: Strong initiatives throughout the state of Florida have been started to have students be well prepared for the transition from high school to the workforce. While a concerted effort is underway to have students be “college and career” ready by mastery of the Florida Postsecondary Readiness Competencies, there is not a current avenue to discuss current evidence-based practices for educators and community members to improve their college-readiness practices to aid in that goal.
