Community: Florida Southwestern Collegiate High School- Lee Campus (FSWC-Lee) is a dynamic learning that is dedicated to creating and sustaining the independent learning process. Freshmen and sophomore students participate in thematic, interdisciplinary instructional units throughout the year with focus on a science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM) curriculum. Junior and senior students are eligible for full-time early admission status at Florida SouthWestern State College with corresponding PERT scores and a 3.0 GPA or higher.

School: FSWC-Lee is four-year public high school enrolling 400 students in grades 9-12. The school opened in 2010 under a public charter, under the direction of Florida SouthWestern State College. FSWC-Lee earned an A grade and ranked 5th in Florida through the Florida Department of Education for assessment-based performance with a score of 1483 out of 1600.

Curriculum: 9th & 10th grade students are engaged in core classes and electives that consist of Human Geography, Technology, Engineering, Chemistry, and Biology. All courses are honors level. Junior and senior level students are dual enrolled at the Florida SouthWestern State College, with 76% of the graduating seniors completing an Associates in Arts in General Studies. 100% of FSWC-Lee students are college-bound, with 96% committing to four-year universities, and 4% finishing their AA degree.

Awards: Graduating 2014-2015 earned \$700,000 worth of accredited college credits in two years and over \$1.8 million in scholarships to in-state and out-of-state colleges and universities.
