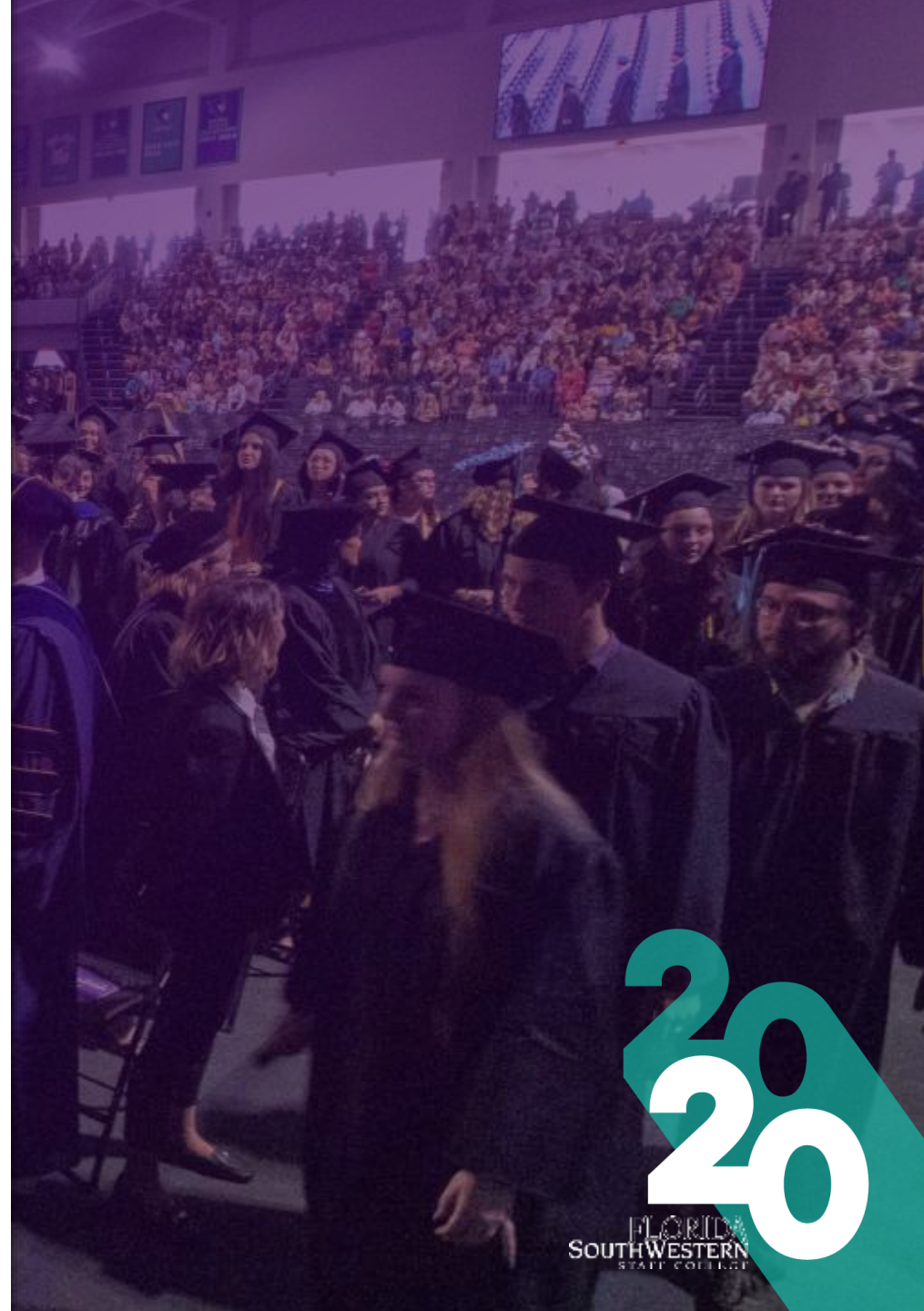

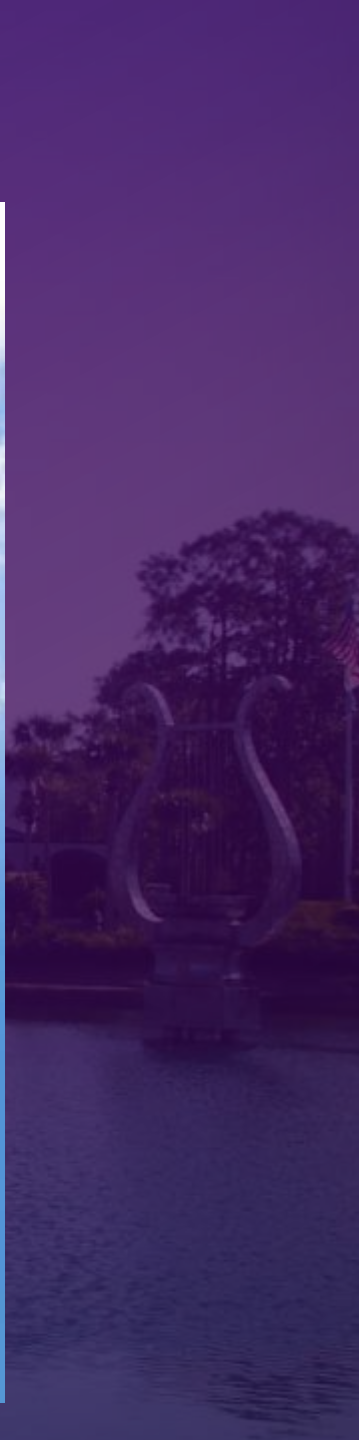

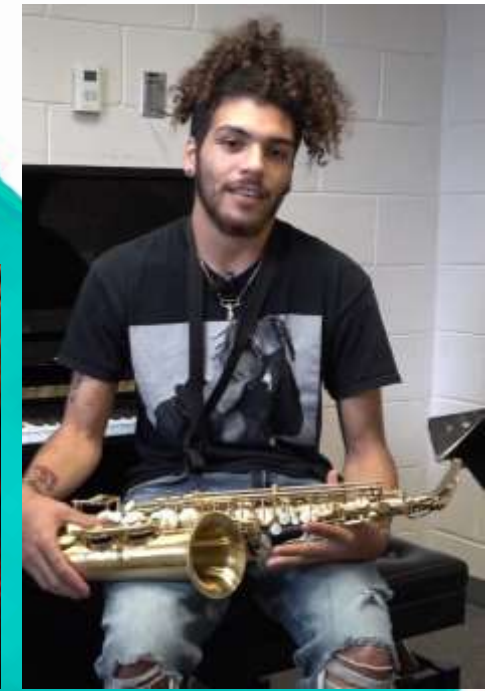
# FSW SUCCESS: SCHOOL OF EDUCATION

- 495 graduates (from class of 2011-18) are employed in Florida's public schools
- 94% are employed in Southwest Florida
- 91% of elementary education graduates are still employed 5 years after being hired
- Bachelor program grads: 5 teacher of the year awards, 11 teacher of distinction awards, and a golden apple finalist



# FSW SUCCESS: SCHOOL OF ARTS, HUMANITIES & SOCIAL SCIENCES

- FSW music program had the highest enrollment & grad rate in it's 40-year history: 2019

## Respiratory Care Program

- Respiratory Care received a Distinguished Credentialing Success Award
  - FSW is 1 of 139 schools to receive the award
  - FSW has received the award every year since 2014

## Dental Hygiene Program

- Dental clinic services 3,000 or more patients in the Fort Myers community annually

- Only SWFL workforce development approved training program in Charlotte

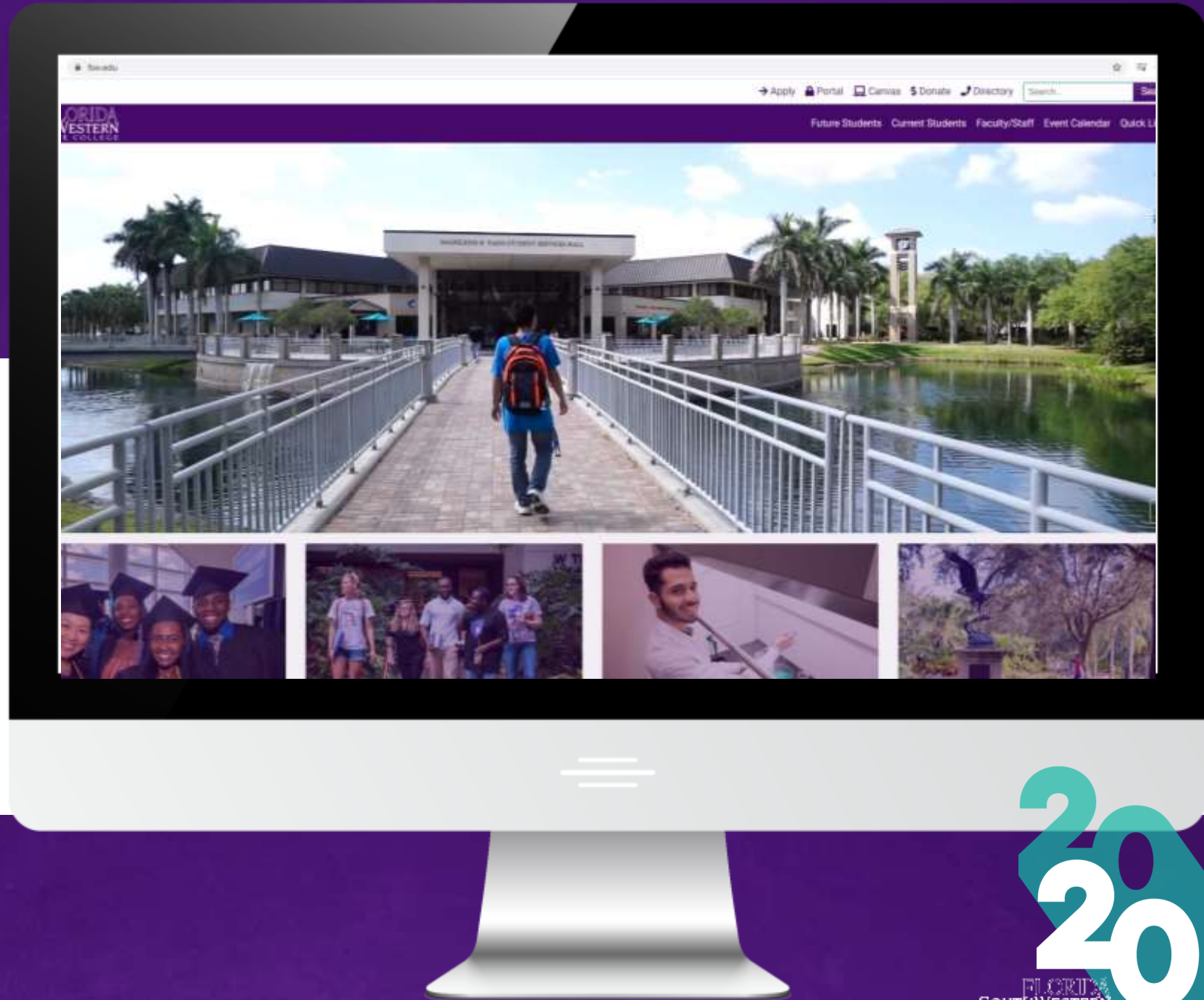
## Nursing Program

  - **19.3 MILLION IN PROGRAM SUPPORT**





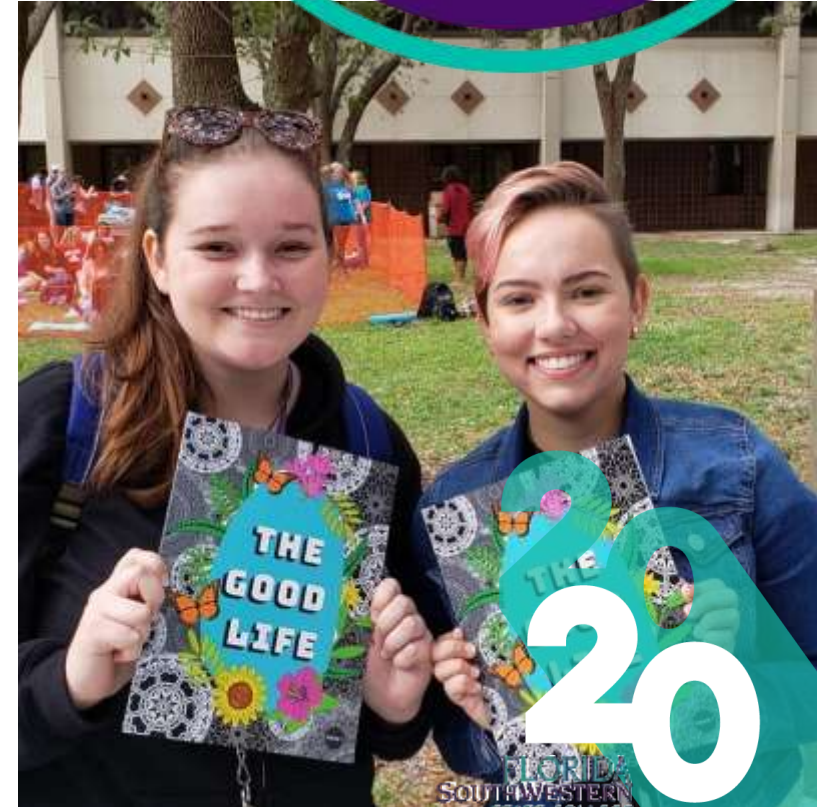
# FSW SUCCESS: BUCS C.A.R.E.

- Focus areas: mental & behavioral health, basic needs, student conduct, safety, violence prevention, diversity and inclusion
- June 2019: Bucs C.A.R.E. food pantries opened at all locations
- October 2019: partnered with Valerie's house to offer young adult grief group to help students feel less isolated after loss of loved one

# HUMAN RESOURCES

- In 2019: onboarded 112 full-time new hires & 568 short-term employees
- Talent acquisition team does classroom presentations on resume prep, interviewing, and job search skills

# FSW SUCCESS: ADAPTIVE SERVICES

- Serves 365 students a year
- Many more students struggle in silence
- 66% retention of students using services year to year

# FSW SUCCESS: F-1 STUDENTS

- 64 F-1 international students
- Up from 48 a year ago
- 46 are non-athletes
- F-1 students come from 32 different countries
- Top 3: Brazil, Germany, and Haiti

# FSW SUCCESS: STUDENT SERVICES

## Advising



- Met with 14,200 students for 23,700 advising sessions in 2019

## Financial Aid



- Up 5.6% in award letters sent out
- Up 4.9% in students receiving aid
- Up 5.3% in aid dispersed to students

## Housing



- 395 residents this year
- 781 housing applications



# FSW SUCCESS: STUDENT ENGAGEMENT

- Fall 2019 attendance
  - 15,373 students checked in to events
  - 6350 students visited campus recreation and wellness center



# FSW SUCCESS: INTERNET TECHNOLOGY

- Laptop kiosks installed on all locations before Fall 2019 semester
- Students check them out free for 4-hour sessions
- 1,331 checked out in the first semester
  - Lee- 757
  - Collier- 491
  - Charlotte- 66
  - Hendry/Glades- 17
