




Unduplicated 12-month headcount and total FTE, by student level: 2021-22






Percent of all students enrolled, by race/ethnicity: Fall 2021




### Percent of all students enrolled, by age: Fall 2021




Graduation rates of full-time, first-time, degree/certificate-seeking undergraduates within 150% of normal time to program completion, by Title IV aid status: 2015 cohort



Award and enrollment rates of degree/certificate-seeking undergraduate students who entered the institution in 2013-14, by cohort




Award and enrollment rates of degree/certificate-seeking undergraduate students who entered the institution in 2013-14, by Pell status and cohort



### **Students not receiving Pell Grants**




Percent of full-time, first-time entering students receiving an award at four, six, and eight years after entry, by type of award and Pell status





4 Years after entry



4 Years after entry 6 Years after entry




Percent distribution of core revenues, by source: Fiscal year 2021


