




Figure 1.2.1a

A.A. Seeking Retention Rates




Figure 1.2.1b
A.S./A.A.S. Seeking Retention Rates




Figure 1.2.1c





Figure 1.2.2a

A.S./A.A.S. Seeking Success Rates




Figure 1.2.2c



College Preparatory Success Rate Associate in Arts Graduates at SUS Institutions







All Degrees/Certs of College Preparatory Student Success Rates: Reading



All Degrees/Certs of College Preparatory Student Success Rates: Writing






