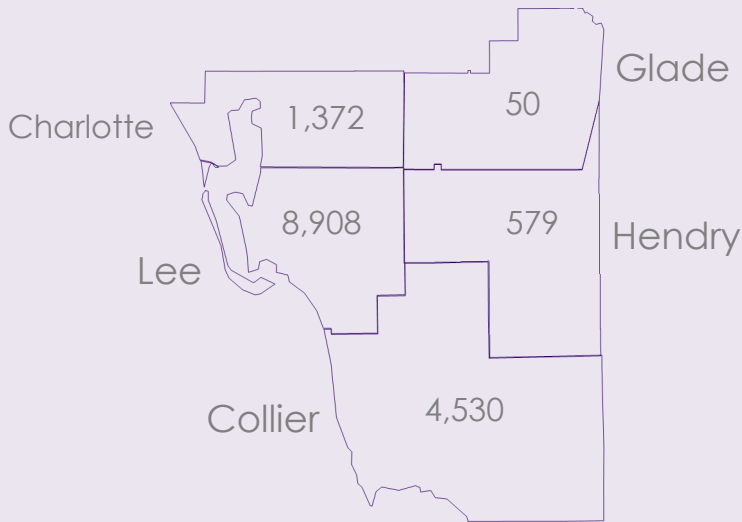

Full-Time Equivalent (FTE)*



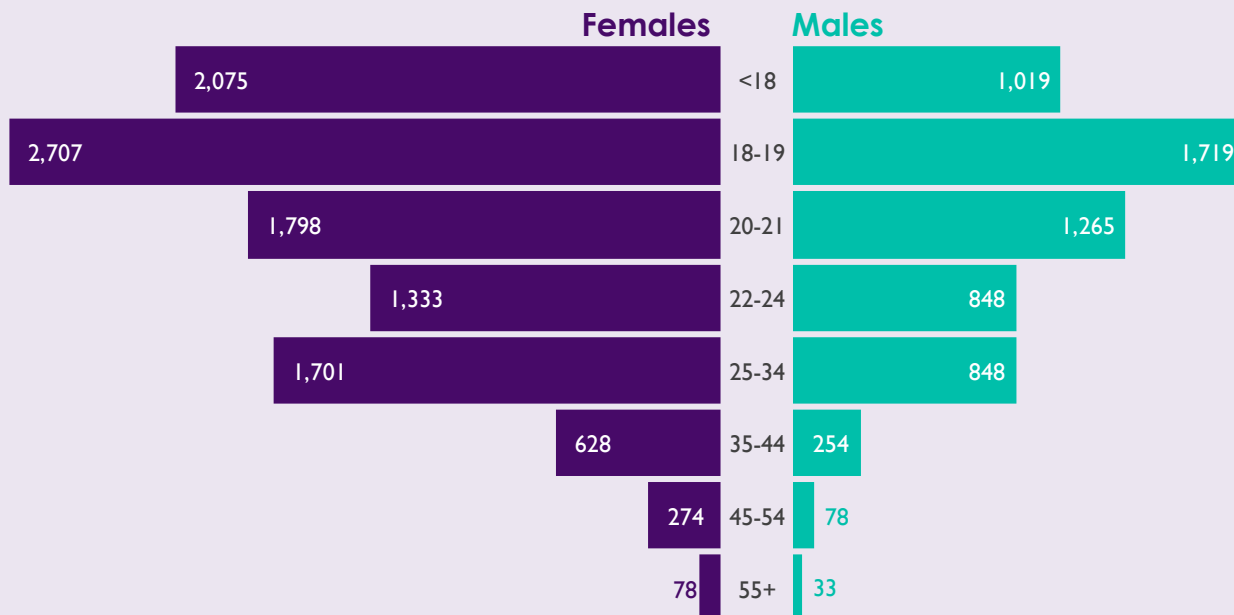

If credit hours are equal to multiple campuses, then student's headcount is assigned to the campus with the lowest headcount enrollment from the prior term. If credit hours are equal between a campus and FSW Online, the headcount is assigned to the physical campus.
