



## If you are in an auto accident:

- Move out of the way of traffic and turn on your hazard lights.
- 2. Call the police, even in a minor accident. If someone is injured, request EMS and/or fire department aid.
- 3. Do not discuss the accident with anyone other than the police or your supervisor.
- 4. Exchange necessary information with the other driver(s). Do not discuss who was at-fault. Don't forget to write down the license plate numbers of all vehicles involved.
- 5. Take pictures with your smartphone if you are able.
- 6. Complete as much of the Vehicle Accident Information Report as possible, which is located in this "Accident Reporting Kit."
- 7. Promptly notify your Supervisor and Risk Management.
- 8. Complete and return the "Vehicle Accident Information Form" and a "Accident-Incident Form" to Risk Management.
- 9. If injured, report the injury to the College's workers' compensation manager.
