- Before moving—BUCKLE YOUR SEATBELT.
- Drive, turn, and stop slowly—SPEED CAN KILL.

- DO NOT exceed the load capacity of the vehicle.
- Post and observe mirrors at all intersections and blind corners.
- Forward view blocked—drive backward or use a flagman.
- Sound horn at intersections, doorways and blind corners.
