Students who wish to earn a National CDA credential may complete the necessary coursework as part of the AA with a Concentration in Early Childhood.

Students who successfully complete the AA with Concentration in Early Childhood degree program with education prerequisites may be eligible to articulate into a baccalaureate in education degree program.
