A student who fails to maintain GPA requirements must notify the chapter advisor immediately. Membership is revoked if the GPA requirement is not met by the following term.

Note: A student must meet all membership eligibility requirements stated in Article IV, Section 2 of Phi Theta Kappa's Constitution and Chapter 1, Section 1 of the Bylaws (www.ptk.org/about/constitution). **A person currently incarcerated is not eligible for membership. A person convicted of a felony crime or any crime whose potential sentence is more than one year is not eligible for membership until three years following completion of all conditions of the sentence including probation.**


How Do I Qualify for Phi Theta Kappa?

To be eligible for membership at Florida SouthWestern State College a student must:

- (1) Complete a minimum of 12 credit hours of associate degree course work
- (2) Earn a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher
- (3) Maintain a GPA of 3.0 or higher throughout the enrollment at Florida SouthWestern State College
- (4) Pay one-time membership dues of \$90 (paid online after eligibility is confirmed by advisor)
