Practical Nursing CC  
into 11 credit hours toward:

- Nursing, R.N., AS

► CC Programs must have been completed at LWTC within the previous five (5) years. Articulated credit awarded upon successful completion of 12 credit hours at FSW toward related AS degree or CCC. Subject to available funding. The issuance and continuation of this scholarship is contingent upon allocation of funds and budgetary resources.
