This is to request a curriculum change for the Dental Hygiene Program as a direct result of the Colleges' curriculum change involving the deletion of BSC 1080 Human Biology and the reduction of credits in MCB 2010C from five credits to four credits. The attached proposed change before the curriculum committee will provide the dental hygiene with a curriculum that will meet the standards outlined by the State of Florida Department of Education Curriculum Framework and Commission on Dental Accreditation standards.

- □ Reduction of 5 credits to 4 credits for the course MCB 2010C Microbiology

	The Commission on Dental Accreditation and the State of Florida Department of Education		
	Curriculum Framework requires the dental hygiene program to have course content that		
	include speech communications. The deletion of the required BSC 1080, two credit		
	course and the reduction of credits in MCB 2010C Microbiology from five to four credits		
	allow the program to add speech communication as a general education course.		
	JUSTIFICATION FOR CURRICULUM ACTION, OTHER EXPLANATORY INFORMATION:		
	The course content in SPC 1017 is fundamental in the processes used in dental practice.		
	Understanding the concepts in speech communication is essential to the development of both		
	oral and written skills for a dental hygienist. One of the primary functions of a dental hygienist is		
	to comprehend and effectively deliver communication skills with diverse populations within our		
	community. Therefore, an introduction to public speaking would enable students to develop		
	effective communication skills needed to enhance employment skills.
