Middle Grades Mathematics Education Catalog update

In April 2014, I was contacted by the School of Education about updating the BS, Middle Grades Mathematics Education program past the published deadline for changes to the catalog. Unfortunately, the final paperwork was never sent to my office for review or approval or to the Curriculum Committee this past year to update the program.

For these reasons, I am approving the change requested in the attached curriculum proposal effective Fall 2015 because students have been advised according to the change outlined in the proposal.

Change catalog language to read:

MAE 3823C Teaching Algebra in Middle School with Practicum

or

MAE 4330C Teaching Methods in Secondary School Mathematics with Practicum

Rationale: The content, assessments, and field experience requirements of both courses are identical, both courses assess the similar competencies and SPAS.

FURTHERMORE, UTILIZING THE SAME PRACTICUM COURSES FOR BOTH THE MIDDLE GRADES MATHEMATICS EDUCATION PROGRAM AND SECONDARY MATHEMATICS EDUCATION PROGRAM IS PRACTICED AT MANY INSTITUTIONS THROUGHOUT THE STATE THAT OFFER BOTH PROGRAMS. (EXAMPLES: ST. LEO UNIVERSITY IN TAMPA, AND INDIAN RIVER STATE COLLEGE IN FT. PIERCE.) THIS CHANGE COMES IN RESPONSE TO THE CHANGES TO THE FLORIDA STANDARDS. NOTE: Changes for the Fall 2014Term must be submitted by the January 2014 deadline and approved no later than the February 2014 Curriculum Committee meeting prior to the start of the next academic year. Changes during midschool year are NOT permitted. Extreme circumstances will require approval from the appropriate dean as well as the Vice President, Academic Affairs to begin in either the spring or summer term.
