Open FSW strives to curate and develop creative, interdisciplinary, intellectually rigorous multimodal resources and accessible content in the service of an inclusive, forward-thinking institution that responds to faculty-student needs, Florida's evolving demographics and an interconnected, 21st century global workforce. The committee will recommend education, training, and support to faculty in the creation, modification, and implementation of open access course materials.

  - FLVC/FALSC committee reported that the zero textbook cost icon chosen by FL students, will be implemented in the near future
  - Discussion of Open Florida's new database of OER content linked to courses
    - Members suggested the inclusion of the following data:
    - Supplementary course materials (lecture slides, quiz banks etc.)
    - Verified accessibility
    - Last date of update
    - Last date of active enrollment for course (when was it last taught?)
