- 4. General Education Assessment update
 - a. Data collection updates
 - 1. Emails were sent to all faculty that were sampled for GenEd for Communicate and Evaluate with instructions about how to participate
 - 1. If any questions come up for LAC coordinators, can look to these emails for a lot of the answers
 - b. GenEd Feedback Booklet
 - 1. E. Pritchett introduced A. Trogan and F. Mayoral as members of the PD (Professional Development) subcommittee
- 5. Syllapalooza
 - a. E. Pritchett updated with recent information that Syllapolooza is back in process. This will be a big role as a coordinator to get that conversation going so faculty understand their stake in the syllabus review process for General Education Competencies, emphasizing our FSW built definitions and how they relate and align to course classrooms.
 - b. J. van Gaalen added that we have 3 PD dates blocked out in the spring and the sessions will provide a day and time for specific schools to come together for the review process.
 - c. M. Fernando noted that oral communication fits very well to speech courses but other courses also give speech presentations, so the speech faculty is looking forward to providing professional development sessions on speech presentations and using the oral communications rubric for faculty.
 - d. J. Charles asked about the timeline for implementing changes to syllabus.
 - 1. J. van Gaalen responded that if your school's PD is in January, you will certainly have time with curriculum committee to have these changes in place for Fall 2021, but even if your school's PD is later, you will still be able to make progress

in implementing these changes quickly as they are an information item and get expedited in curriculum committee.

- e. The committee discussed how multiple integrals and multiple supplementals are ok, and part of LAC communication role is to raise awareness accordingly
- f. A. Trogan shared insights from conversations about English department GenEd competency conversation, including responses from a survey for high impact course faculty. She is considering a pre and post survey surrounding the PD conversations to see if any input will change from the previous survey to help the department concretely see their progress.
- g. J. Charles: PD sessions for Syllapalooza for the Spring will be framed via discipline or competency?
 - 1. J. van Gaalen noted that sessions across 3 dates will be for five schools with breakout sessions for each department to work on their syllabi within their departments.
- 6. DataVersed Newsletter
 - a. GenEd Story
 - 1. D. Barnard provided an article that showcases the journey of an arts class through this last GenEd CREATIVE competency pilot and introduces our final rubric for the Analyze competency.
 - b. Discussed encouraging everyone to consider contributing articles, including examples such as book review of relevant assessment readings!
 - c. Syllapalooza and October PD sessions will also be announced in Oct issue
