



2017-2018 Admissions Lottery Process

1. An open enrollment process was held that allowed any and all students to create a Lottery Registration number on or before a deadline of April 4 at 12:00 p.m. In the end, 275 individuals registered seeking a 9th grade seat, 44 seeking a 10th grade seat, and 30 seeking 11th or 12th grade seats.
2. As established and publicized, a lottery will be open to the public and held on April 20th at 6:30 p.m. in the U building here on the FSW Lee Campus. For each grade level, an independent third-party random number generator will be used to randomly sequence the identification numbers and to establish the ranked order to offer seats.

The only exceptions to this randomly assigned sequence are the following provisions from our approved charter documents:

- a. Employee Dependent Preference – dependents of full time FSW State College employees as verified by the H.R. Department are guaranteed a seat at FSWC – Lee.
 - b. Sibling Preference – If a family has more than one sibling residing at the same residence and one sibling is extended an offer of (or is currently in) attendance to FSWC- Lee, other siblings are also immediately eligible to attend.
 - i. In the end, 118 initial offers will be extended to freshmen based on the provisions above.
 - ii. Sophomore seats are offered based on availability using the sequence created by the lottery.
 - iii. Junior and Senior students must be fully dual enrollment eligible.
3. Results of the Lottery will be posted via the school website as a .pdf file the same evening as the lottery and or you may call if you have a specific question related to your student's situation.
 4. All students receiving an initial offer of acceptance will be notified via U.S. mail and should arrive by April 27th to the address provided on your Lottery Registration. **Acceptance and return of the provided packet is due back by May 3rd at 3:00. Fax or email submissions are NOT acceptable, we suggest physically dropping off the packet to avoid uncertainty. Not returning the paperwork before the deadline is treated the same as declining the offer.** Sophomore seats are only offered when they become available and will likely be processed after the conclusion of the school year.
 5. In the event that additional seats become available, offers will be made the week of May 15th in the order established by the lottery.
