



Florida SouthWestern Collegiate High School - Lee Campus is a public charter high school with an open enrollment policy. All FSWC - Lee students follow an honors level and STEM based curriculum, providing students with the opportunity to graduate with an associate degree and high school diploma simultaneously.

Our curriculum and student management philosophies follow the nationally recognized pre-collegiate / collegiate model where students take honors level classes during their freshmen and sophomore years in a traditional high school facility. For eligible students, the junior and senior years consist of dual enrollment classes taken on the campus of Florida SouthWestern State College where students are offered all the challenges and rewards of being independent learners. This course of study affords participants the opportunity to earn a high school diploma and an associate of arts degree in just four years of study. With this tremendous opportunity comes an expectation to be highly motivated and focused on academic pursuits beginning the very first day of the very first year of school. Potential students should be prepared to have academics as their primary school priority and are expected to exhibit a high degree of personal integrity and social maturity during their time at FSWC - Lee.

In order to participate, all potential students are offered the process outlined below:

1. FSWC - Lee will host a large open house on December 14th as well as prearranged small group tours during November, December, January, and February. Other than personal preference, there is no practical advantage to attending one style or the other. Regardless of when you apply during the open lottery period, all applicants have an equal chance of selection.

2. The lottery process is not based on merit as we run an open enrollment campus. Additionally, participation does not limit your LCSD or other school options in any way. Lottery registrations for all four grade levels can be accomplished online or in person between November 16th and March 28th. The school web page has a large red button to link participants to the lottery registration.
3. The actual lottery will happen in the Building U, Room 102 and is open to the public on April 12th, 2018 at 6:30. This process will rank order applicants and we will extend offers as seats become available and until all grade levels are full. To provide for continuity of service to students, vacant seats in the sophomore, junior, and senior classes are only filled in the fall and through this described lottery process. Junior and Senior students must be fully qualified for dual enrollment classes by July 1, 2018.
