### ***SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY***

Florida SouthWestern Collegiate High School-Lee (FSWC-Lee), formerly known as Edison Collegiate High School, opened its doors to students in the fall of 2010 on the Florida SouthWestern State College Lee County campus in Fort Myers, Florida. As a fully accredited charter school in the State of Florida, FSWC-Lee serves students in grades 9 through 12 drawn from Lee County through an open enrollment policy. Currently there are 410 students. The current student population is 58% female and 42% male. Approximately 49% of students indicated their ethnicity is white, 30% Hispanic/Latino, 9% black, 7% Asian, and 5% multi-racial. 25% of students receive free or reduced lunch.

The purpose of FSWC-Lee is to provide a quality academic experience for high school students seeking the challenge of high academic standards, rigorous curricula, and college-level study at a small high school, which promotes a caring environment focusing on critical thinking, communication, and collaboration for each individual. **The four-year curriculum provides the opportunity for students to complete a high school diploma and an Associate in Arts degree simultaneously.**

### ***CURRICULUM***

The academic program for 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade students is organized in a traditional 7 period school day with 49-minute classes. All high school core courses are taught at the honors level. FSWC-Lee 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> graders attend Florida SouthWestern State College as full-time dual enrolled students. 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade students must have an unweighted cumulative grade point average of 3.0 and meet the minimum score requirements of the Next-Generation ACCUPLACER, ACT or SAT, to be eligible for dual enrollment.

FSWC-Lee offers honors classes in English I and II, Algebra I and II, Geometry, Biology, Physical Science, World History and U.S. Government. Additional classes include World Cultural Geography, Environmental Science, Marine Science, STEM 1 & 2, Critical Thinking through Art, Peer Counseling, Personal, Career & School Development, Humanities 2 Honors, Math Data for Financial Literacy, Yearbook, Personal Fitness and H.O.P.E.

FSWC-Lee students must have a minimum of 24 credits taken in high school years per Florida Department of Education statute. Within these 24 credits, the following subjects are required:

**English:** 4 credits

**Mathematics:** 4 credit (must include Algebra I and Geometry)

**Science:** 3 credits (must include Biology) (2 must have a laboratory component)

**Social Studies:** 3 credits (1 credit U.S. History, 1 credit World History, .5 credit American Government, .5 credit Economics)

**Fine and Performing or Practical Arts:** 1 credit

**Physical Education (HOPE):** 1 credit

**Electives:** 8 credits
